Race day schedule - men's race

9:00	Race starts in Williamson Park
12:45	Race finish in Williamson Park (estimated time)
13:00	Podium presentation (15 minutes after race finish)

Race day schedule - women's race

14:45	Race starts in Williamson Park
17:15	Race finish in Williamson Park (estimated time)
17:30	Podium presentation (15 minutes after race finish)



THE ROUTE

The race starts in Williamson Park Lancaster travelling out on Wyresdale Road to Grab Lane and completes laps of Quernmore Road, Postern Gate Road, past St Peter's Church, Quernmore, Bay Horse Road, Proctor Moss Road (closed Road), Little Fell Lane, Langthwaite Road, and Grab Lane. On the final lap the race finishes by continuing onto Wyresdale Road, then turning right into Williamson Park with the race finishing past the Ashton Memorial.

THE MODA KOM /QOM COMPETITION

There will be a King of the Mountains and a Queen of the Mountains competition in the respective men's and women's races. The action takes place on Proctor Moss Road (see map opposite). The first 4 riders across the line will score points (5,3,2,1) on each lap except the final lap.

THE BRUCCIANI ICE CREAM COMBATIVITY AWARD

This award will be decided by the Commissaire panel and will be awarded for each race.

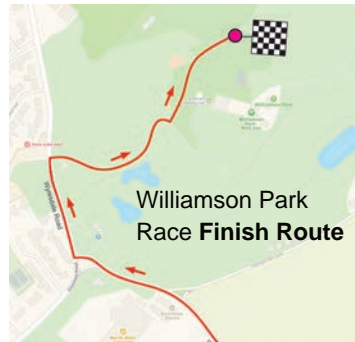

Men's Race

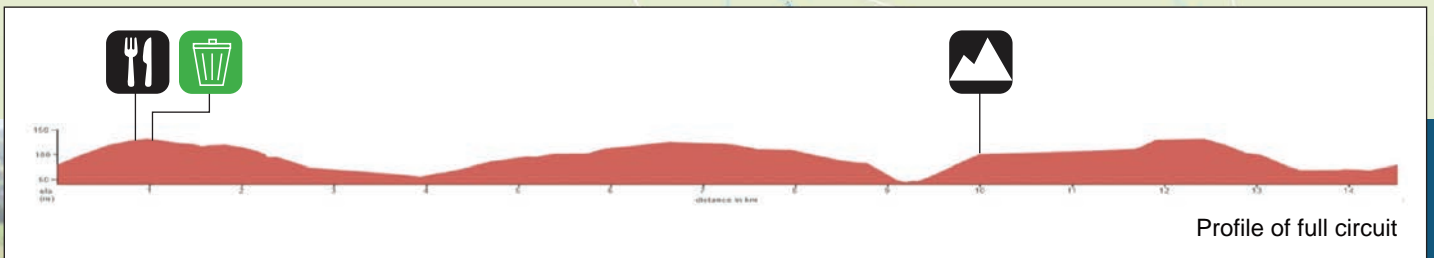
Race circuit to be **completed 10 times** before return leg to Williamson Park Lancaster

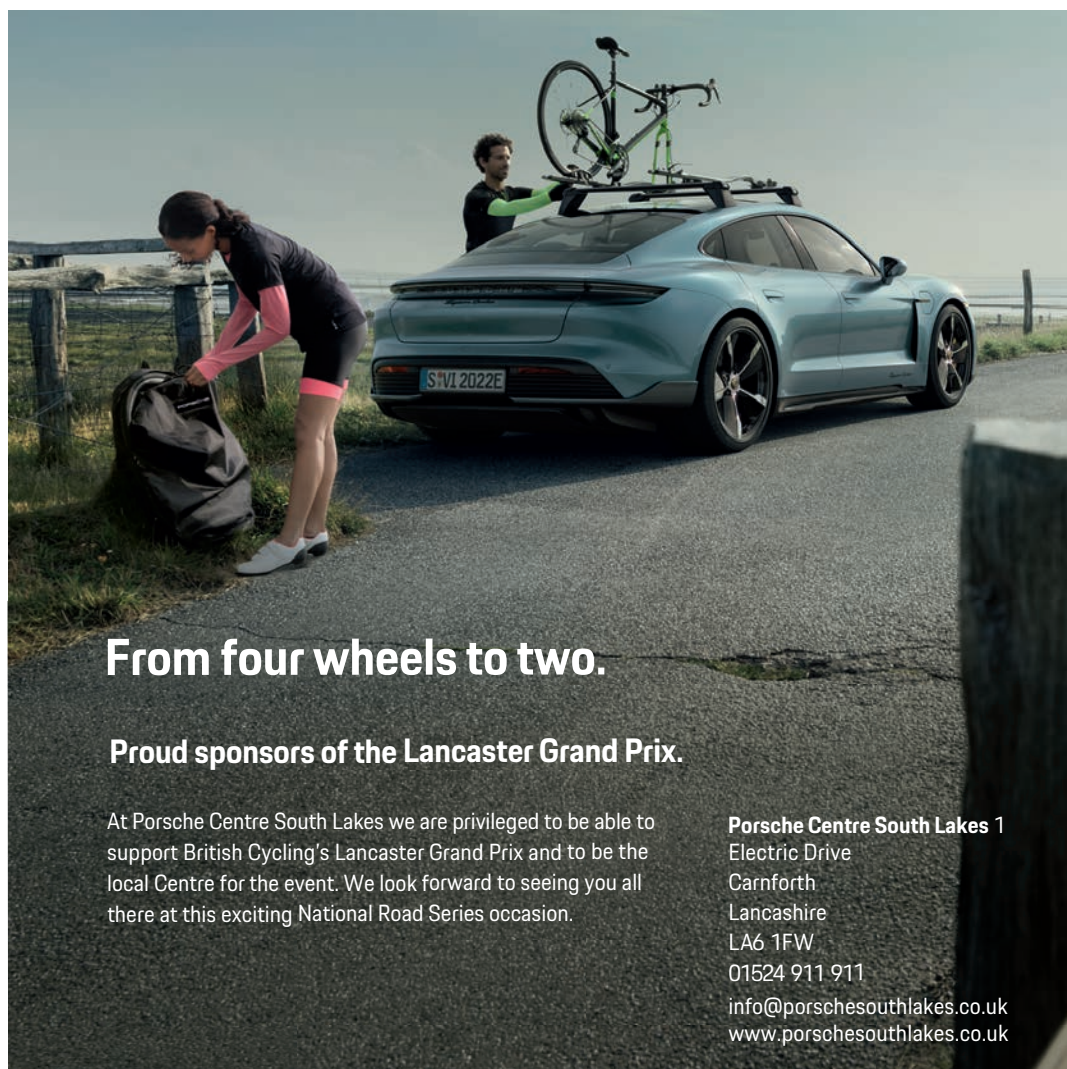
